Board Meeting Summary

May 17, 2007

A Master Plan Progress Presentation was made to the University of Dayton Board of Trustees on May 17, 2007, followed by a work session on May 18. Some of the items discussed during the presentation included a learning and living philosophy presentation by Dr. Pestello, and a conversation about facility priorities by Dr. Curran. Burt Hill presented the history of the project and discussed the facilities initiatives supported by the new master plan. The presentation culminated in the implementation of Strategic Plan initiatives and the resulting master plan concepts.

Afterward, attendees had a great work session and conversation regarding programming and how it is being implemented into the master plan, and how UD philosophies are being integrated into this programming. Other planning issues were discussed such as parking priorities, site circulation, new construction, and development schedule.
