### Consultant Update - Walker Parking

Walker is continuing to analyze parking occupancy and other parking system data collected in December. This data is being compiled into a draft report evaluating the current parking system adequacy to be reviewed with Darlene Holder, UD Director of Parking Services, and Burt Hill. Walker is evaluating specific parking issues revealed by the focus group interviews and community interviews conducted by Burt Hill. Walker is also examining the potential for recommending various methods of reducing overall parking demand through the use of appropriate transportation demand management techniques (TDM), such as increased use of transit, bicycles, ride sharing, and financial incentives. With this in mind, Walker is also progressing with the analysis of transportation system alternatives, operating procedures, and estimates of costs for initiating a transportation system.

Completion of the parking supply/demand tasks, including projections of future parking adequacy and parking solutions, and completion of the Transportation System Analysis is contingent upon completion of campus building and site programming to be provided by Burt Hill. Walker is proceeding with the financial analysis of the parking system and the financial implications of implementing various alternatives. Comparable parking permit fees and citation fines were collected and the financial analysis portion of the study is progressing.
